The winning essay will be announced in December at the SAANZ Annual Conference, to be held at Massey University Albany. The award consists of a citation from the Association, \$500 and possible referral of the paper to New Zealand Sociology for consideration for publication.

Eligibility

To be eligible to enter you must be:

- Enrolled in a degree at a New Zealand tertiary institution at the time of writing the paper
- Enrolled in sociology or a related discipline where you are considered to be using a sociological perspective
- A current postgraduate student member of SAANZ

Entries:

The paper should be an original piece of work that has not already been published or accepted for publication. It should be between 5,000 and 6,000 words and should follow the stylistic conventions of New Zealand Sociology Journal. Joint authorship is permitted, subject to both authors meeting the eligibility criteria. All entries must be accompanied by evidence of enrolment status (an email from a Head of Department or supervisor will suffice).
