Entries are now open for the 2022 SAANZ Undergraduate Essay Prize. The award will be presented to the author(s) of a submitted paper that is considered by the judging panel to best represent undergraduate scholarship in the sociology discipline

The winning essay will be announced in December at the SAANZ Annual Conference, to be held at Massey University Albany.

The award consists of \$300. In addition, SAANZ will support the winning author to submit their paper to the Global Undergraduate Awards Programme. This support will come in the form of tailored feedback and guidance, as to be discussed between the awardee and the members of the executive.

Eligibility

To be eligible to enter you must be:

- Enrolled in the third year of a undergraduate degree at the time of writing the paper
- A current undergraduate student member of SAANZ
- Considered to be studying within a sociological perspective
- Have written support from a member of your respective faculty.

Entries:

The paper should be an original piece of work that has not already been published, accepted for publication or submitted as an assignment. It should be between 2,000 and 3,000 words and should follow the stylistic conventions of New Zealand Sociology. Joint authorship is permitted, subject to both authors meeting the eligibility criteria. All entries must be accompanied by a letter of support from a member of your faculty.
