## 2025 Undergraduate Essay Prize in Sociology CALL FOR PAPERS

**Entries are now open for the 2025 SAANZ Undergraduate Essay Prize.** The award consists of \$500 and will be presented to the author(s) of a submitted paper that is considered by the judging panel to best represent undergraduate scholarship in the sociology discipline.

### Entries

The paper should be an original piece of work that has not been published, accepted for publication, or submitted as an assignment (although substantively reworked versions of assignments will be accepted). It should be between 2,000-3,000 words and follow the stylistic conventions of *New Zealand Sociology*. Joint authorship is permitted, subject to both authors meeting the eligibility criteria.

### To be eligible to enter, you must:

- be enrolled in the third year of an undergraduate degree at the time of writing the paper.
- be a current undergraduate student member of SAANZ.
- be considered to be studying within a sociological perspective.
- have written support from a member of your respective faculty included with your entry.
